(Bradenham Road, West Wycombe)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER, 2017

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order, which will temporarily prohibit any vehicle from proceeding, except for access, in that length of Bradenham Road, West Wycombe, which commences 70 metres either side of the railway bridge.

The alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure will be via Bradenham Road, West Wycombe Road, Oxford Road, Bellfield Road, Parker Knoll Way, Glenisters Road, Hughenden Road, Hughenden Avenue, Valley Road, Cryers Hill Road, Missenden Road, Wycombe Road, High Street, Martinsend Lane, Station Approach, Link Road, Missenden Bypass, Aylesbury Road, London Road, Wendover Bypass, Nash Lee Road, Risborough Road, Station Road, Ellesborough Road, New Road, Bell Street and vice versa.

The closure is required whilst Network Rail works take place and it is anticipated that the works will commence on 22 July 2017 and will take approximately 1 day between 2300 and 0500 to complete.

The Order will come into operation on 22 July 2017 when the appropriate signs are lawfully displayed and will continue for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the said works have been completed whichever is the earlier.

Penalties for not observing these restrictions will be as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.
