# 7. High Speed Rail (London-West Midlands) Bill

IN PURSUANCE of section 239 of the Local Government Act 1972, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a meeting of West Wycombe Parish Council will be held at The Church Room, High Street, West Wycombe on Thursday the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 2014 at 8 o'clock in the evening to take into consideration and determine upon the expediency of opposing in Parliament the High Speed Rail (London-West Midlands) Bill deposited in the session 2013-14 and also for the purpose (if deemed expedient to oppose such Bill) of passing such resolutions as may be necessary or expedient in connection with the opposition to such Bill.
