- 6. Planning Applications & decisions: **14/07161/FUL -15 Rosemary Close High Wycombe** Householder application for construction of single storey rear conservatory following demolition of existing sun lounge

14/06915/CTREE-West Wycombe Village Hall -Fell Silver Birch T1 and Sorbus Aucuparia T2

**14/06914/CTREE-West Wycombe Hill Church Lane** -Thinning (selective felling) of trees in woodland on West Wycombe Hill

**14/06837/FUL-142 Chorley Road West Wycombe** -Householder application for construction of long roof extension dormer window with two smaller dormer windows in connection with loft conversion and fenestration alterations

**14/06828/CTREE-Flint House Bradenham Road** -Crown lift Birch T1 by removing 8 x lowest laterals to provide 4 metres clearance from ground and leave no growth below second telephone line; crown clean and remove deadwood from Prunus T2; reduce upper section of Yew T3 above approximately 1.5 metres height by approximately 0.5 metres in line with lower crown; crown reduce Hornbeam T4 by approximately 0.5 - 1 metres (15% reduction)
